I received a Bachelor of Music in Vocal Performance and Piano from Marylhurst College in 1973, and studied voice with Elizabeth Peter-Schoenauer at the Mozarteum in Salzburg, Austria, while a student in the University of Portland's Salzburg Extension Program in 1971-72.

While a member of Kay Lee's Playbox Players (1969-79), I performed and taught improvisational theater and assisted Kay Lee in her choreographic duties for musicals at various Portland-area high schools. In addition, I choreographed "Fiddler On the Roof" at a local high school and directed "Dames At Sea" at The Production Company.

From 1975-78, I was co-owner/producer of Slabtown Theater in the Friendly House Community Center in NW Portland. In addition to performing there, I prepared vocal arrangements for "Slabtown Follies" (1940's Revue) and arranged civil war songs and composed original music for a staging of Steven Vincent Benet's poem, "John Brown's Body". With a fellow performer, I created and performed a revue of Porter and Coward songs and sketches that was presented at Portland Civic Theater, the Coaster Theater in Canon Beach, Oregon, and at New York's Don't Tell Mama Cabaret Club. I have held the position of choral conductor at churches in New York and Portland, as well as being a featured soloist.
